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## **Latin II**

Latin II is a course that will build on the grammar and vocabulary learned in Latin I. Students will study the chapters of *Ecce Romani II*. Students will also have the opportunity to work on their ability to understand and speak Latin in a safe and supportive environment. In addition to the study of grammar, vocabulary, and speaking, students will explore Roman history, mythology, culture, and government in a way that makes the “dead” language come alive and become relevant to 21<sup>st</sup> century students. An exploration and analysis of ancient Roman culture will be especially prevalent in this course. Students will also refine their critical reading, critical thinking, public speaking, and English grammar skills by engaging in group work, presentations, project-based learning, lectures, and discussion. Upon completion of this course, students will have been introduced to the majority of the Latin grammar they will encounter when they begin reading authentic Latin prose and poetry.
